Leamington Medical Village - Phase 1 & 2

In Learnington, Ontario, Phases 1 and 2 of the Learnington Medical Village were successfully completed in 2009. Situated on 197 Talbot Street West, the Village is within walking distance of Learnington District Memorial Hospital and Grossi Physiotherapy & Sports. Within a few years of operation, the Village now rosters 19,400 patients and is acknowledged as the premier centre for health care in the Learnington and surrounding area.

The Village is home to the Learnington & Area Family Health Team, 13 Family Practice Physicians, several Nurse Practitioners, a Registered Nurse, Practical Nurse, Audiologists, a Chiropractor, Dietician, Pharmacist, Physiotherapist, Social Worker, and a Specialist in Obstetrics and Gynecology. On-site facilities include the Learnington Medical Pharmacy, Learnington Medical Supplies, Medical Laboratories of Windsor, Helix Hearing Centre, and the Hippie Chick Cafe.

New Construction - Phase 3


The final phase of Learnington Medical Village is currently under construction. The medical Village of approximately 65,627 sq.ft. continues to be constructed.
